**Seminole Prevention Coalition/SCCPTA Mini-Grant Criteria:**

1. An Seminole County PTA/ PTSA may apply for only one mini-grant during the academic year, resulting in a maxium of one mini-grant per PTA/PTSA to be awarded.
2. A mini-grant will not exceed the amount of \$300 and documentation is required to support the total dollar amount requested.
3. Funds may be used to enhance or establish programs as each PTA/ PTSA feels are most needed within their specific school.
4. Although funds do not have to directly support prevention awareness, units accepting mini-grant funding must agree to enhance prevention awareness at their school by facilitating the involvement of the Seminole Prevention Coalition at a local event. Events must be attended by at least 25 individuals from your school community. Coalition involvement will be determined before donations are approved.

Qualifying events include (but are not limited to):

- Educational workshop for parents, teachers or students
- Health Fair
- Student Assembly
- School PTA meeting

5. Monies must be used for a program during the school year the mini-grant is awarded.
