Advocacy

Advocacy refers in a broad sense to efforts to promote, in the domain of humanitarian aid, respect for humanitarian principles and law with a view to influencing the relevant political authorities.

<u>Gov. Ron DeSantis signed a number of education bills into law that will be</u> <u>effective July 1, 2023</u>

- <u>HB 1035</u> provides for a teacher apprenticeship program, and authorizes the Office of Inspector General to investigate allegations and reports of suspected violations of rights
- <u>SB 256</u> bans the teachers union from automatically taking union dues out of their paycheck
- <u>HB 379</u> gives teachers more power about how students use devices and social media at school
- <u>HB 477</u>, will put stricter term limits on school members. Eight years will now be the maximum
- <u>CS/HB 1537</u> allows students to take a different test than the SAT or ACT to qualify for Bright Futures scholarships



Also, join us in welcoming <u>Jen D'Ortona</u> as the 2023-2024 SCCPTA Reflections Chair!




